

# Directions to Oakley, Hampshire

## A34

If you are travelling north on the A34 then turn onto the A303 at Bullington Cross and follow the directions from the A303 using the "M3 J7/ A303" directions.

If you are travelling south on the A34 from Newbury then exit the A34 at the turn signed Whitchurch, Litchfield, Woodcott and Dunley.

Follow the old A34 into Whitchurch, past the water tower and over the crossroads.

Take the next left turn into Dances Lane and follow the road through Lynch Hill Park.

At the T-junction with the B3400 turn left.

Follow the B3400 through Freefolk, Laverstoke, Overton and Deane.

### Country road

After you pass Oakley Hall, on the right, take the next right onto Rectory Road.

The narrow road turns left and then right before passing St. Leonard's Church, continue along Rectory Road, passing Oakley manor on the right and a small pond on the left, until you arrive at the junction with Oakley Lane.

You are now at the village duck pond and the Chapel is opposite you facing the pond.

### Avoiding country road

Continue along the B3400 passing The Beech Arms on the left and going under a railway bridge.

Continue up the hill and take the second right turn into Pack Lane.

Follow Pack Lane until the crossroads with Oakley Lane.

Turn right onto Oakley Lane

Follow Oakley Lane as the road swings to the right and then left again, under a railway bridge.

Stay on Oakley Lane, passing the school lay-by, on the right and local shops, on the left. (These may well be the best places to park!)

Oakley Lane stops at a T-junction with Hill Road, next to the village duck pond.

Oakley Methodist Church is then just to your left, facing the pond.
