Directions to Oakley, Hampshire

M3 J7/ A303

If you are using the M3 and exiting at Junction 7 follow the signs for the A30 Basingstoke.

Stay on the A30, Winchester Road, and go straight over the traffic lights. There is a sign suggesting that you should take the road on the left at the lights for Oakley, but this uses a very narrow, winding country road. These directions will take you to Oakley by an alternative route.

If you are using the A303 take the exit signed Non Motorway traffic A30.

Stay on the A30, passing the Crematorium on the left until you reach the junction with the A33.

Turm left onto the A33 past the Wheatsheaf Hotel and follow the A30 until it merges with the traffic coming from the motorway.

You will pass a sign suggesting that you should take the road on the left, before the roads merge for Oakley, but this uses a very narrow, winding country road. These directions will take you to Oakley by an alternative route.

Stay on the A30, over another set of traffic lights, until you reach the Sainsbury's roundabout.

Take the first exit, straight over and continue along Winchester Road, down the hill.

At the next roundabout take the first exit, left, onto Heather Way.

Follow Heather Way until the mini-roundabout junction with Kempshott Lane.

Take the 2nd exit, right, onto Kempshott lane.

Follow Kempshott Lane until the traffic light junction with Pack Lane.

Turn left onto Pack Lane.

Follow Pack Lane, under the railway bridge, until you reach the crossroads with Oakley Lane.

Turn Left onto Pack Lane.

Follow Oakley Lane as the road swings to the right and then left again, under a railway bridge.

Follow Oakley Lane, past the school lay-by on the right and local shops, on the left. (These may well be the best places to park!)

Oakley Lane stops at a T-junction with Hill Road, next to the village duck pond.
