

Directions to Oakley, Hampshire

M4 J11/A33

If you are using the M4 and exiting at Junction 11 then follow the signs to the A33 (Basingstoke).

Stay on the A33 Swallowfield by-pass to a roundabout at the end of the dual-carriageway.

Go straight over the roundabout, 2nd exit, staying on the, now single-carriageway, A33 towards Basingstoke.

Follow the A33 to Basingstoke, until you are back on a dual-carriageway approaching the "Tesco's" roundabout.

Take the 3rd exit, signed M3, Town Centre and A33.

Stay in the left-hand lane to the Crockford Lane Roundabout.

Take the first exit and stay in the left lane, past Lidl and over the traffic lights and up to the Reading Road roundabout.

As you approach the roundabout the lane will split into two lanes. Take the middle lane.

Take the 4th exit onto the ring road, signed A339 Ring Road & Newbury and exit the roundabout in the right hand lane down the slip road.

Once on the ring road, take the middle lane (the left lane will go to the Town centre).

Stay on the ring road, signed A339 (Newbury). This will take you over the Houndmills roundabout.

As you approach the next roundabout, stay in the middle lane and take the 2nd exit, signed A339 (Newbury).

At the next roundabout take the first exit, left, onto Roman Road, signed Winklebury / Worting.

Follow Roman Road until the mini-roundabout junction with the B3400, Worting Road. Turn right (2nd exit), signed Whitchurch, Overton and Oakley.

Follow the B3400, through Worting and Newfound.

When you are in the 30mph section through Newfound you will pass a Garage on the left and you will see The Fox Public House a little further along the road.

Turn left at The Fox onto Fox Lane.

Stay on Fox Lane until the Pack Lane crossroads and go straight over the crossroads onto Oakley Lane.

Follow Oakley Lane as the road swings to the right and then left again, under a railway bridge.

Follow Oakley Lane, past the school lay-by on the right and local shops, on the left. (These may well be the best places to park!)

Oakley Lane stops at a T-junction with Hill Road, next to the village duck pond.

Oakley Methodist Church is then just to your left, facing the pond.
